Flagler County Sheriff's Office Vulnerability Study Commander Mike Lutz, Flagler County Sheriff's Office

- Commander Mike Lutz with the Flagler County conducted a Hammock Dunes site visit in May 2022 and surveyed the Community with several members of the Hammock Dunes Safety Committee and members of the HDOA Board. Commander Lutz began his presentation by confirming Hammock Dunes is a safe community with low/minimal crime. Further, he stated all solutions documented in the report are recommendations.
